

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING RUBBISH FIRES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEND, MINNESOTA,
THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH BEND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to burn any sweepings, trash, lumber, leaves, straws, grass, papers or other combustible material within the boundaries of the Township of South Bend, except in the manner hereinafter provided in this Ordinance.

Section 2. No person or persons shall within the limits of the Township of South Bend, Minnesota, cause or permit to be made or build any fire in the public streets of said Township.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful to burn garbage or any other material, which is offensive to the smell and which tends to create a deep smudge in any place in the boundaries of the Township of South Bend.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful to burn any material enumerated in Section 1 of this Ordinance within the fire limits of this Township or on any property, which has been zoned other than residential, and on which a building is located, except in a refuse burner constructed of iron, steel, brick, concrete or stone, in a substantial manner. Said refuse burner shall be approved by the Chief of the Fire Department of the Township of South Bend. No refuse burner shall be constructed within twenty (20) feet of any building or structure. No material shall be burned on property located in the residential section of the Township of South Bend in such proximity to a building or structure, as to constitute a fire hazard.

Section 5. It shall be unlawful to burn any material enumerated in Section 1 of this Ordinance, or to burn any other material within the boundaries of the Township of South Bend except between the hours of 3 PM and 9 PM on any day except Sundays and holidays when the hours shall be 12:00 noon till 9 PM.

Section 6. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as prohibiting burning of trash or other materials at the Township dump.

Section 7. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to accumulate or permit to accumulate any brush, rubbish, lumber, grease, oil or other materials, which might constitute a fire hazard in the Township of South Bend.

Section 8. No person shall wilfully call out the Fire Department without just cause. Every person calling or phoning for the Fire Department

shall give his name and address to the person receiving such call, which shall be recorded and turned over to the Chief of the Fire Department.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall not apply to the burning of any material, at any time, when done so with the permission and at the direction of the Fire Chief or Assistant Fire Chief of South Bend Township.

Section 10. Every person violating the provisions of the Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the County jail for not more than ninety (90) days.

Section 11. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
